Job description: The Director of Communications & Outreach will direct Communications and Outreach programs. This position requires some travel to WPGA Member Clubs. This position is full-time.

Qualifications: Previous employment with a state or regional amateur golf organization is preferred. A college/university degree, or its equivalent, is required along with strong communication and interpersonal skills, knowledge of and passion for the game of golf, and the ability to relate to the golf community.

- Previous golf administration background preferred
- Understanding of staff/volunteer relations
